



Topic key knowledge

Transport networks link places together and allow for the movement of people and goods. Transport networks are usually built where there is a high demand for the movement of people or goods. The journey that food travels from producer to consumer is measured in food miles. Agricultural land use in the UK can be divided into three main types, arable (growing crops), pastoral (livestock) and mixed (arable and pastoral). An allotment is a small piece of land used to grow fruit, vegetables and flowers. Changes to the weather and climate (temperature, weather patterns and precipitation) can affect land use. Soil fertility, drainage and climate influence the placement and success of agricultural land. Farming is affected by the climate (typical weather), topography (shape of the land) and soil type of the farm's location. Vegetation belts are areas where certain species of plant grow.
